Practical Sessions

- 10 hours of driving for automatic transmission cars.
- Manual transmission course (4 hours of manual transmission and 8 hours of automatic transmission lessons)

- Driving lessons can be scheduled for a minimum of 1 hour to a maximum of 2 hours per lesson, per day.

Upon Successful Completion

Students who successfully complete both the theory and practical sessions will be entitled to a Course Completion Certificate which will benefit the student in 2 ways:

1. Take a G1 Exit Road Test 8 months from the day the student received his/her G1 instead of having to wait the mandatory year
2. You will be eligible for a maximum insurance discount
